

Proposed charter changes for February 12, 2019 election:

PROPOSITION NO. 1

Shall Section 5-1 of the City Charter of the City of Bethany, Oklahoma, be amended to remove the residency requirement for the City Attorney, and to make non-substantive updates to Section 5-1, all as set forth in Resolution No. 1527.

PROPOSITION NO. 2

Shall Section 3-1 of the City Charter of the City of Bethany, Oklahoma, be amended to change the residency requirements of the City Manager, specifically to allow the City Manager to reside within ten (10) miles of the city limits, and to make non-substantive updates to Section 3-1, all as set forth in Resolution No. 1527.

PROPOSITION NO. 3

Shall Section 8-1 of the City Charter of the City of Bethany, Oklahoma, be amended to include an additional exception to the prohibition of dwelling units of a greater density than twelve (12) per acre by providing for approval as part of a Planned Unit Development and in accordance with the City of Bethany Comprehensive Plan and Zoning Ordinances, and to allow for the alteration of dwelling units, all as set forth in Resolution No. 1527.

PROPOSITION NO. 4

Shall Section 5-2 of the City Charter of the City of Bethany, Oklahoma, be amended to remove the residency requirement for the Municipal Judge, to make non-substantive updates to Section 5-2, to remove the reference to a minor violations bureau, to provide for a monthly report to the Council, and to provide for oversight on the collection of fines, costs, and forfeitures, all as set forth in Resolution No. 1527.



PROPOSITION NO. 5

Shall Sections 2-1 and 2-3 of the City Charter of the City of Bethany, Oklahoma, be amended to provide for term limits of three (3) consecutive four (4) year terms in the offices of Councilmember and Mayor beginning January 1, 2020, to provide that election or appointment to a partial term shall not count toward the eligibility limitation, and to make non-substantive updates to Sections 2-1 and 2-3, all as set forth in Resolution No. 1527, and published in accordance with the laws of the State of Oklahoma.
