AWARD OF CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR BETHANY LIBRARY

BETHANY (Jul. 25, 2017) – The Bethany City Council awarded a contract for \$5,738,000 to Shiloh Enterprises, Inc. as the lowest responsible bid for construction of the Bethany Library Complex. The approved project includes park and pond improvements, walking trails and lighting. There were 13 bidders for the library/park project.

The Bethany Library Groundbreaking Ceremony at 6700 NW 35th at Mueller will be held on Saturday, August 12, at 10 a.m. Everyone is invited to help dig. There will be a special digging area for children, who will receive commemorative hard hats to keep.
